Bob Guyette Scholarship



Marquette Academy and Bob Guyette are pleased to announce the formation of the Bob Guyette Scholarship Fund. The Scholarship will be available for all incoming Marquette Academy High School students starting the 2020-21 school year.

Bob Guyette played Basketball at Marquette and is the program's leading scorer with 2,009 points, leading rebounder (1,510), most career free throws (477), most rebounds in a single game (36), most points in a game (51), and most points in a season (991). In Bob's junior year he led the team to its first post season trophy by winning the IHSA District title and the Regional Title. The Crusaders advanced to the Championship game of the Sectional becoming one of 32 teams remaining in Tournament play when there was only one class in High School.

Bob continued his collegiate basketball career at the University of Kentucky where he was a member of the squad that squared off against UCLA and John Wooden in the 1975 National Championship game. Guyette had 16 points and 7 rebounds in that game.

Marquette Administrators will oversee the scholarship funds in accordance with the school's policy regarding funds of this nature. Donors interested in contributing to the fund may inquire at the main office for information regarding this purpose.
