The Circle

A dark blue circle with the words 'MARQUETTE ACADEMY' in white on the upper half and 'Catholic Education Since 1859' in white on the lower half is the main symbol of unity for the Catholic parishes who belong to the Marquette Academy family. With regard to the name, it is justly chosen as there are 16 letters in the name of Marquette Academy and 16 parishes and missions who are a part of the Academy's service area. Between the words are two small Jerusalem crosses, one on the right and one on the left. The Bible, the foundation of our faith, includes the Old and New Testament. Fittingly, these crosses are reminders of our Catholic educational purpose. They symbolically support the words Marquette Academy, just as the Catholic community will do with the school.

There are three gold rings that surround the dark blue circle. The two closest to the blue circle, one on the inside and one on the outside, serve as reminders of God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. The third ring of gold, often seen last, and possibly the most important, completely encompasses all aspects of the Academy and student and is symbolic of God the Father.

The Shield

The shield is a heather style shield similar to those carried by the Crusaders of the Middle Ages. The cross on the front of the shield, a Jerusalem cross, is the same style cross which adorned the Crusaders' shields. The cross has the French fleur-de-lis at each of its four points. The fleur-de-lis used here has many important meanings both to our Catholic faith and to us locally. The words translate from French as "lily flower". In the early church it was often seen as a symbol of Mary, as she was referred to in the Song of Solomon as the "lily among thorns". This symbol was again used in 14th century France as a religious symbol representing the Holy Trinity, as well as virtues of faith, wisdom and chivalry. One can see the direct connection between our Academy and these virtues as well; our Catholic faith, wisdom from education and chivalry in service to our neighbors and community. The fleur-de-lis' use and symbolism has expanded locally as the basis of the logo of the Boy Scouts of America, whose founder W.D. Boyce was from Ottawa. Additionally, in the Academy's home city of Ottawa, the fleur-de-lis is the center point of its city flag. It represents the heritage and pays homage to the early French explorers. It was Fr. Jacques Marquette and his fellow explorer Louis Joliet who helped to bring the Catholic faith to this area. Thus, it is fitting that we pay respect to this early Catholic missionary and priest with the naming of our new school: Marquette Academy.



HISTORY OF MARQUETTE ACADEMY

Ottawa, Illinois

The history of Marquette Academy is one of one hundred sixty four years of service to Ottawa and the surrounding area. It is the history of generosity and concern typical of those who take the gospel teachings in earnest. It is the history of those who value their right to educate their children in accordance with their beliefs.

It all began in 1859 with Dean Terry, then pastor of St. Columba Parish. It was he who invited the Sisters of Mercy to open St. Joseph's School on the corner of Paul and Washington Streets to about one hundred young boys and girls in the growing Catholic community.

In 1900, St. Joseph's school was closed and a new five-story structure was erected and opened as St. Xavier's School for girls. In order to provide a secondary education for boys in the area, Bishop Schlarman, in 1945, requested that the building be remodeled and co-education be undertaken. In September of 1946, with thirty boys registered, the school re-opened under the name of Ottawa Catholic High School. Due to rapid growth, during the years 1949-1950, a new two-story building was added to the south, which provided six new classrooms, a gymnasium, and a cafeteria. The name of the school was changed to Marquette High School.

In 1990, the then 90 year old five-story structure was demolished and replaced with a new two story structure, making one large building covering the entire city block. The newest building contains twelve classrooms, 2 labs, a chapel, library and administrative offices. It was dedicated by Bishop John J. Myers on December 1, 1991. The following year, a new grotto was added on the northwest corner completing the campus.

Beginning in 2010, Bishop Daniel Jenky made sweeping changes in the structure of the catholic schools in the Peoria Diocese. In Ottawa, the two grade schools of St. Patrick and St. Columba closed and were merged and consolidated with the high school. The new entity, a Pre-K through grade 12 school, was re-named **Marquette Academy** and is a part of the Ottawa Catholic Community. The current Academy consists of two campuses with one administration. The grade school, PreK-8, is housed in the old St. Columba grade school building on Washington St. Two blocks down the street, the high school, grades 9-12, remains in its original location on the corner of Paul and Washington Streets.

With the experience of these years, Marquette is a blend of the old and the new with the vitality of generations of Crusaders whose cry will always be:



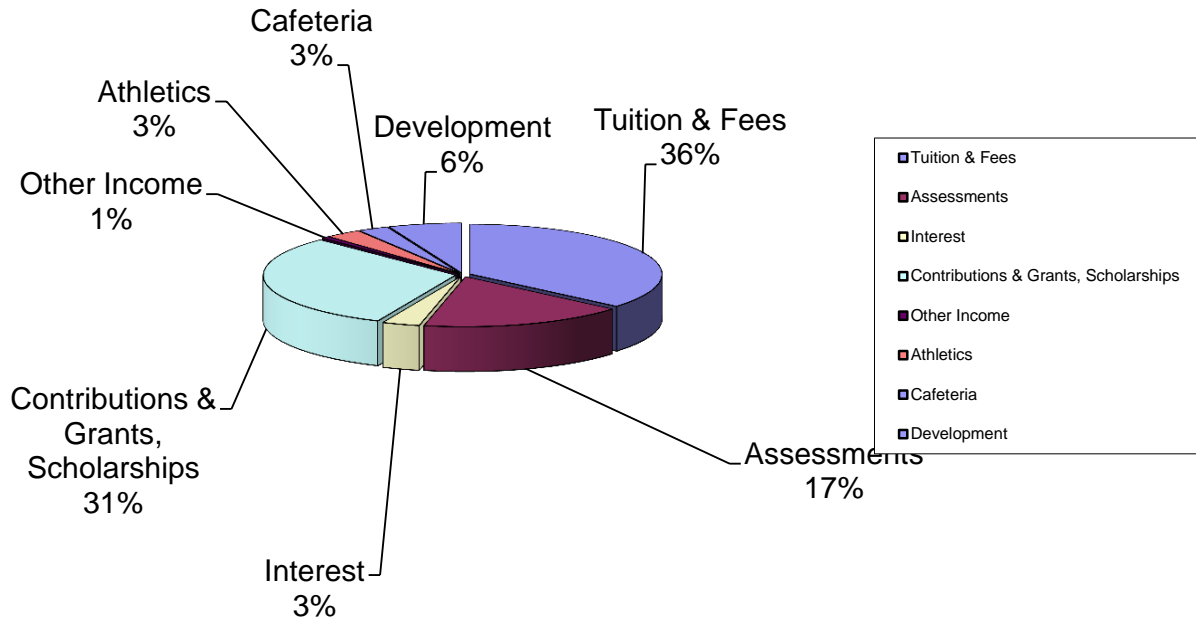

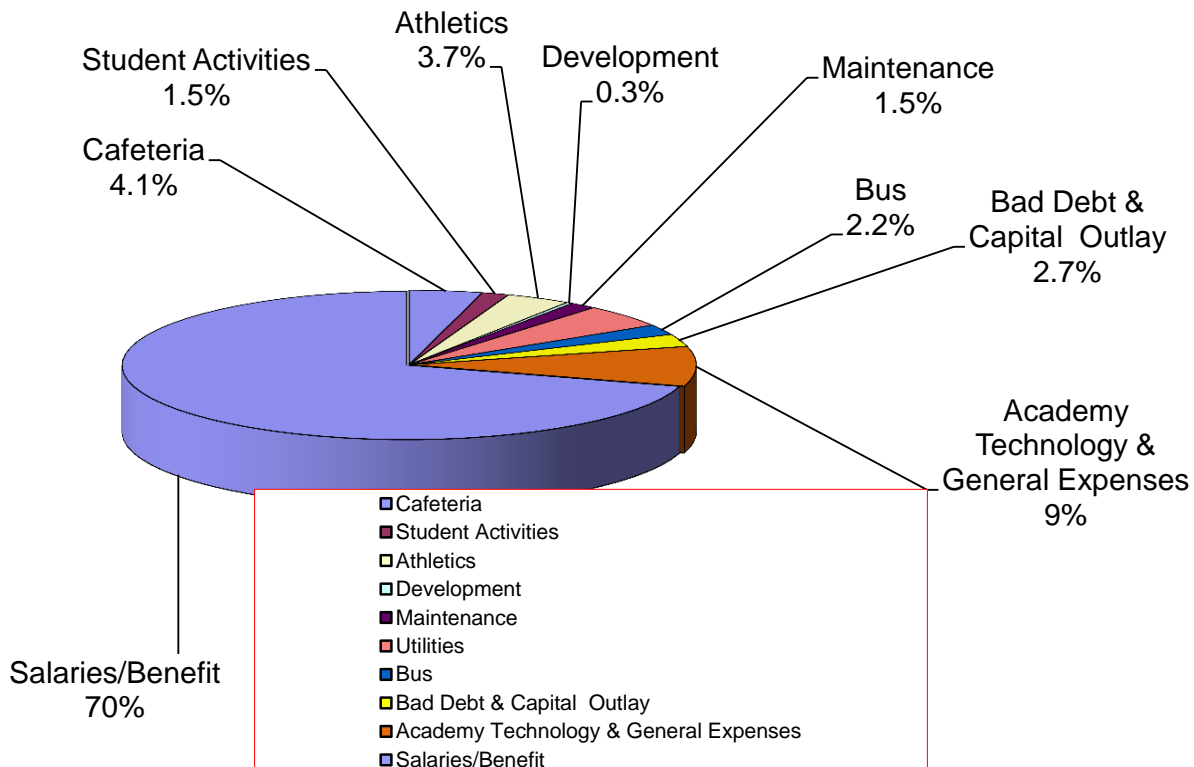
Total Revenue \$4,968,347.57

Marquette Total Expense 2022-2023 Actual

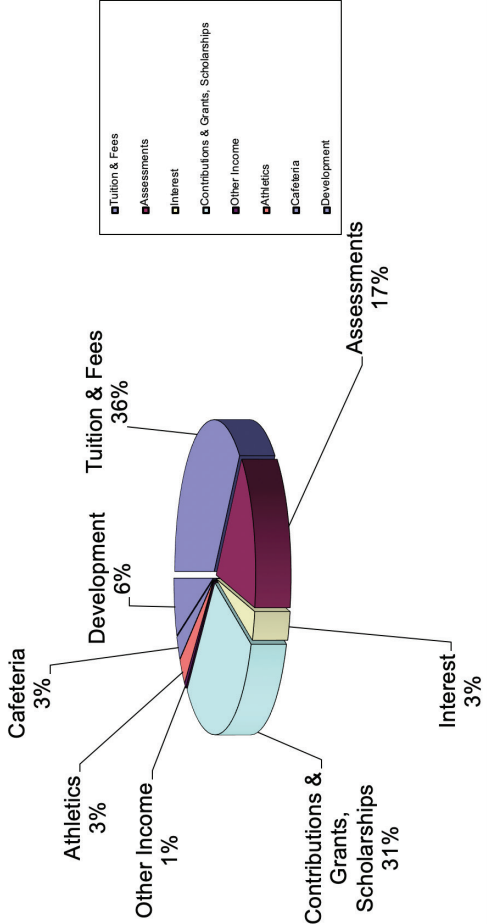

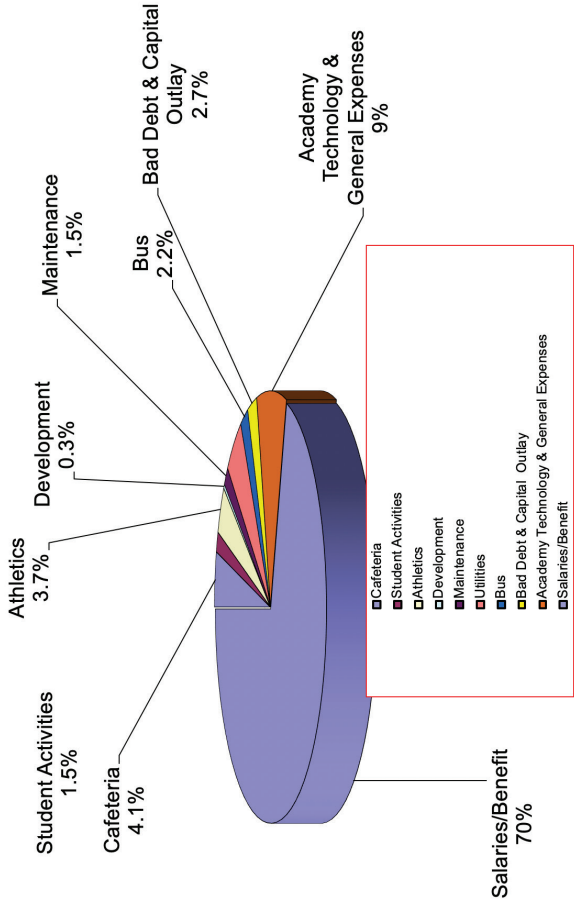

MARQUETTE MAY MERRIMENT

Forty three years ago, Marquette parents and friends Joe and Muriel (Punch) O'Brien had an idea for a fundraiser-a gourmet catered formal sit-down dinner with a silent and live auction of merchandise that was donated by the community. That first event took over a year of planning and a very large committee of volunteers. It was a HUGE success. Bader Gymnasium was transformed into a Parisian experience and packed with nearly 500 guests. Marquette May Merriment and the Marquette Development Office were born. This first dinner-auction netted nearly \$112,000-a substantial amount in 1983. May Merriment became the talk of the town and was considered the premiere social event in the area. We were the first to stage an event like this. Many other organizations have patterned similar events after this one over the years.

Since inception, the gala has consistently raised an average of \$180,000 per year and has netted the Academy well over \$5 million dollars. Many changes have taken place through the years; however, the price still includes an elaborate gourmet dinner with an open bar. It is still held in Bader Gym which is converted into an elegantly decorated themed dining room and auction gallery. Auction items and services range in value from \$10 to thousands of dollars.

Marquette May Merriment is the largest fundraiser at Marquette and still involves hundreds of volunteers. Formal invitations are sent in April, however, reservations are always open to anyone who wishes to support Marquette Academy and have a fun night out. Those who are not able to attend the event in-person can help by purchasing a Big Cash Raffle ticket for \$100 to win \$5,000, \$2,500, \$1000, \$500 or a Grand Prize of \$25,000.00! Online bidding is available. May 4, 2024 will mark the 42nd staging of this event.
